Deer Park After School Program

Deer Park After School Program is one of our 4 free recreation based After School Programs in Georgina, and one of our longest standing programs.

The staff always have something fun planned for the participants. Whether this be a cool science experiment, handsy craft or even a walk in the nearby forest - there is an activity for everyone.



Programs In Action

Deer Park Licensed Child Care

Our Licensed Child Care Before and After School Care program at Deer Park Public School provides a Ministry of Education licensed and quality care for children ages 4 to 6. They follow [How Does Learning Happen?](#), Ontario's Pedagogy for Early Learning. We provide breakfast and afternoon snacks, outdoor and indoor play, arts and crafts, science, community building, health and wellness, literacy activities, and child-led play.

Our educators are trained, and experienced individuals, led by supervisors who are members in good standing with the College of Early Childhood Educators. Each of our staff are trained in First Aid and CPR, [High-Five Principles of Healthy Child Development](#), and participate in ongoing professional development through Jericho Youth Services and external trainers. Thanks to [CWELCC](#) the rate is \$12/day for B&A Care and \$22/day for day camps.
